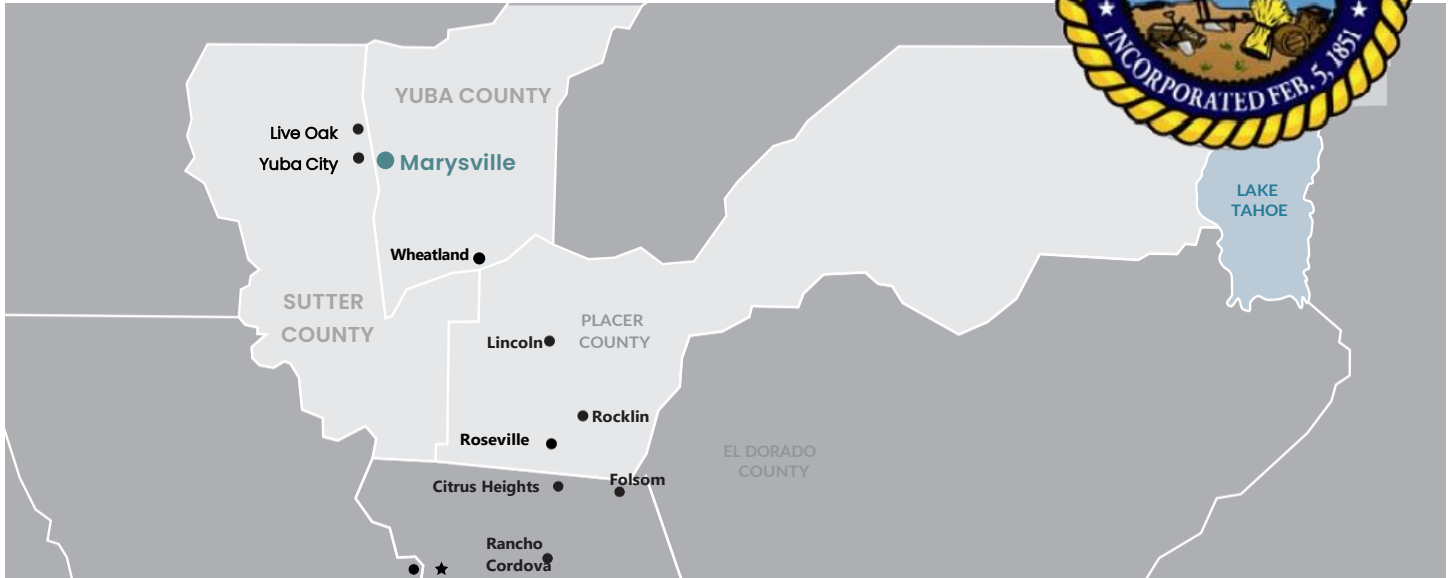


COMMUNITY PROFILE:

The city of Marysville, population 12,580, is a unique and charming city located in Yuba County. Nicknamed the “Gateway to the Gold Fields” and one of California’s historic Gold Rush cities, Marysville is a city of distinctive shopping, dining and entertainment. The city’s location and proximity to Highways 99, 70 and 20 provide easy access to many of the area’s major attractions such as the Sutter Buttes, Hard Rock Hotel and Casino Sacramento and the Toyota Amphitheatre, and Sacramento. Marysville is home to Ellis Lake, the Bok Kai Temple and Parade, the Peach Festival and the Gold Sox (a summer collegiate wood-bat baseball team).
